Hello from your Chrysalis Community! The ball is rolling for the next Chrysalis Flights. We have Lay Directors for both the girls and boy's teams, team selection is now taking place, and training will begin soon. The Flights take place at Immanuel Methodist Church-Grace Campus, Covington and the dates are as follows:

Girls Flight: January 17th - 19th, 2009

Boys Flight: February 14th - 16th, 2009

We will need lots of help in a variety of areas. First and foremost, we need prayer. Please be in prayer for team formation and training, as well as how you might participate and/or sponsor. Any youth attending a Chrysalis Flight needs to fit the following profile:

1. Must be in grades 9 - 12,
2. Should have a general understanding of the nature of the weekend,
3. Should be interested in exploring and deepening their faith, regardless of church affiliation,
4. Does not have to be actively involved in a church or youth group (but hopefully will seek one after the weekend).

Registration forms for the Flights can be found on the web site. Please note that there are 4 forms that need to be filled out (two by the participant and parent, one by the sponsor, and one by a reference-preferably a pastor or youth minister). Remember, we must have at least 10 youth signed up, two weeks prior to the weekend. Therefore, it is never too early to get those registrations in! Please contact me if you have any questions or concerns. Prayer and food preparation/serving information will be made available at the next Gathering and hopefully on the web site, soon.

Remember...The Upper Room believes that Chrysalis is the #1 outreach of an Emmaus Community. Please pray for, and participate in helping these Flights "get off the ground" for the youth of this area.
